DIRECTIONS

From the South: Leave M6 at Junction 25, at end of slip road turn left at roundabout onto dual carriage heading into Wigan. Follow A49 for approx 2 miles to junction opposite ASDA, turn left and follow the signs for the DW stadium to the traffic lights by Red Robin Inn. Turn right into Anjou Boulevard, past cinema, Leisure Centre on right after the bend.
From the North: Leave M6 at Junction 27, at top of slip road turn left towards Standish, right at the T-junction, left at the mini-roundabout in Shevington into Old Lane. Continue down Wigan Road to large crossroads controlled by traffic lights. Turn right and continue to lights near Red Robin Inn. Turn left into Anjou Boulevard, past cinema, Leisure Centre on right after the bend.
